POLICY

Stolen, Lost or Damaged IT Equipment

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure maximum safekeeping of Zayed University's IT equipment.

2. Scope of Application

This policy applies to all ZU students and employees, whether full- or part-time, paid, or unpaid, temporary or permanent.

3. Policy

3.1 The IT equipment (computers, cameras, mobile devices, iPads, etc.) that has been provided by the university to the user (employees and students) to perform their jobs, is the property of Zayed University. It is therefore the responsibility and obligation of the user to care for, safeguard, and keep the equipment as close to new condition as possible.

3.2 The IT equipment is for academic/administrative use only and not for personal or other use.

3.3 All users must inspect the equipment and be satisfied that they are in good working order before checkout. Any fault(s) during inspection shall be reported at the time of checkout. Users who miss or fail to inspect the equipment at checkout will be responsible and shall not be excused from fault(s) identified during check-in.

3.4 The user may be financially liable for lost or stolen equipment depending on the nature of the incident or negligence of the user.
