POLICY Social Media

1. Purpose

To regulate the use of social media within Zayed University ("**University**"), in line with internal rules and regulations, and whilst adhering to FAHR's Guidelines for "Use of Social Media by Federal Government Employees" and "UAE Laws Related to Defamation and Cyber Crime."

2. Scope of Application

Users from University colleges, institutes, departments, initiatives, and student body are expected to abide by the University Social Media Policy and Procedures and to stay in line with the UAE Laws Related to Defamation and Cyber Crime.

3. Definitions

4. Policy

- **4.1** The administrative unit responsible for the University social media platforms the Government Communications Department ("GCD") operates within FAHR guidelines, concerning procedures to be followed on official University social media platforms.
- **4.2** The GCD is responsible for the production and management of social media content for the University's platforms such as Facebook, LinkedIn, X, Instagram, YouTube, and other social media platforms.
- **4.3** All University colleges, departments, and student initiatives that have presence on social media need to verify their accounts with the GCD, and ensure they abide by the University Social Media Policy and Procedures and are in line with the UAE Laws Related to Defamation and Cyber Crime. The GCD shall develop guidelines and conduct awareness training sessions for all concerned so that everyone is aware of this policy and the related laws.

4.4 All University faculty, staff, and students are expected to adhere to ethical and responsible online behavior, in line with the UAE Laws Related to Defamation and Cyber Crime.
